During the September meeting, we shared patterns and ideas for making Holiday themed projects. Some of the items you create over the next couple of months will be offered for sale at the Lakewood Arts Holiday Gift Show and Sale from November 21, through December 31, 2021 to raise money for the Guild.

Some items that were suggested for the Holiday Gift Show are Leather Ornaments, Holiday themed Cards (yes – made out of leather), practical items such as belts, wallets or bags. The following restrictions apply: No work made from kits and no jewelry items allowed in the Holiday Gift Show.

At the October meeting we will have Craft-Aids, holiday themed patterns and leather available. We will also have 4-inch diameter round die-cut leather pieces for making coasters. These can be tooled with any pattern you wish, including Holiday themes.
