## Section V Board of Directors

- A. In 2000, the Guild voted to elect a Board of Directors to conduct the Guild business.
- B. The Board of Directors shall consist of all officers and three (3) elected Board members.
- C. The Board of Directors shall have general supervision of all the interest of the Guild, and shall authorize the payments of indebtedness, shall fill vacancies not provided for in the various offices of the Guild, it's own members, and Guild officers, and shall appoint a committee of not less than three (3) members at least two (2) weeks before the February meeting to audit the Treasurer's report of collections and expenditures.

## ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

## Section I Membership

- A. Any person interested in Leather craft and who is willing to uphold the By-Laws, may become a member upon the payment of dues and registration fees, if any.
- B. Membership will consist of (2) classes:
  - Active Limited to those willing to uphold Article IV, Section I, A., and with full voting rights. This includes Individual and Family memberships.
  - Honorary Those elected as Honorary by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership present at a regular meeting, but carry no voting rights.

## Section II Annual Membership Dues

- A. Dues and registration fees for membership shall be:
  - Individual Membership dues shall be Thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per yearfor each member.
  - Family Membership dues shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) per year. This includes Spouses and children (under the age of eighteen years or a full time college student.
  - For new Individual Memberships and Family Memberships the dues shall be the full \$35.00 prior to July 1 and \$20.00 and \$25.00 respectfully for the rest of the year.
